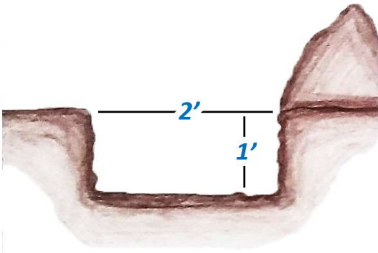


# Care of Acid Loving Plants

*Blueberries, Azalea, Rhododendron,  
Endless Summer Hydrangea (for blue flowers)*

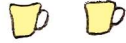
## Planting Instructions:



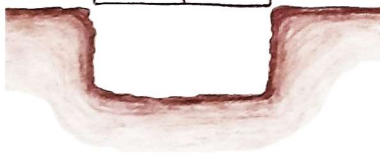
### Step 1:

Dig a large planting hole - 2' in diameter and 1' deep

2 cups Iron Sulphate

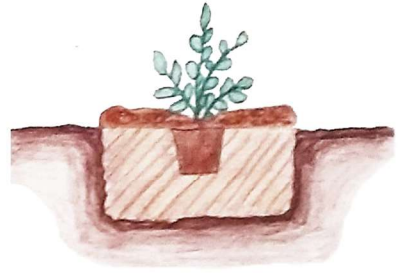


1/2 Peat Moss    1/2 Soil



### Step 2:

Add 1/2 peat moss, 1/2 soil, and 2 cups Iron Sulphate to planting hole and mix in



### Step 3:

Plant into soil mix, water, and add an organic mulch around the plant

## Yearly Maintenance:

### Every Spring:



Sprinkle one cup Aluminum Sulphate around the plant and water or hoe into the soil. Add mulch.

### May, June, July:



Fertilize with an Acid Loving Fertilizer (1 Tbsp fertilizer/gallon of water every 1 to 2 weeks)
