
# **Care of Acid Loving Plants**


## Blueberries, Azalea, Rhododendron, Endless Summer Hydrangea (for blue flowers)





Step 1:

Dig a large planting hole - 2' in diameter and 1' deep



Step 2:

Add 1/2 peat moss, 1/2 soil, and 2 cups Iron Sulphate to planting hole and mix in




Step 3:

Plant into soil mix, water, and add an organic mulch around the plant

## **Yearly Maintenance:**

#### **Every Spring:**



Sprinkle one cup Aluminum Sulphate around the plant and water or hoe into the soil. Add mulch.

#### May, June, July:



Fertilize with an Acid Loving Fertilizer
(1 Tbsp fertilizer/gallon of water
every 1 to 2 weeks)
